- ⇒ Judges speak to individual children about their animals.
- ⇒ Classrooms are open for everyone to view the results of Arts/Craft judging.

#### 12:30 - 1:00

1:00 - 1:30: Guest speaker - Everyone assembles in Room 3

#### 1:30 - 2:30

- ⇒ Pet Parade and Ribbon Presentation.
  - Children station themselves with their pets around the central grassy area and each child who has a pet is invited to tell the audience something about them.
  - Pet judges award the ribbons for the junior and senior 1st, 2nd, 3rd places and the Supreme Champion.
  - Pack up and put the exhibits in parents' cars, then go home.
