Tuesday, 12th September 2023.

Arrive at Nokomai Station at 10am - Depart at 1 - 2pm.

We are going to take advantage of an exciting opportunity to visit a local wool farm.

On Tuesday, 12 September the whole-school will travel in private cars south down S.H. 6 past Athol, taking the signposted left turnoff at Parawa, then along the shingle road to visit the Hore family station.

Nokomai is a historic high-country sheep and cattle station. The fine merino wool they produce is their pride and joy, and they supply New Zealand Merino who in turn provide their clip to two well-known brands, Smartwool (USA) and Icebreaker (NZ).

While there the children will watch the shearers and crew in action in a 10-stand shearing shed and learn about how the wool is graded and pressed into wool bags.
