SKOOL LOOP

Simply Google Skool Loop on your phone and follow the instructions so you can receive your newsletters, important notices and submit absences.

* If you already have the app, give it a refresh by deleting it and then downloading it again.

ABSENCES

* A gentle . . . but extremely important reminder . . . Any ABSENCES must be advised no later than 9:15 on the day. If you know in advance of an absence then advise us in advance A.S.A.P as this impacts on the teacher's planning, children's learning and possibly any itinerant teacher who may be intending to visit to support your child.

Kia ora whanau,

We are excited to be planning the first week of the **School Swimming Lessons** at Mossburn Pool from Monday 19th February to Friday 23rd February. This is week 4 of this term and a change from the provisional date. There will be another swim week in week 8 from Monday 18th to Friday 22nd March. Lessons will run from 9:30–11:30 approximately. The pool will be opened at 9:15am for the children to change, but they may come in their swim togs.

This is part of the Garston school Health and Physical Education curriculum and all children are expected to participate unless they have a valid reason for not doing so. All children attending will take part in the ten lessons with an instructor. The children will be assessed and placed in an appropriate group for their level. This may change every few days, depending on progress.

Assistance from parents:

We are asking parents to provide transport in cars this year. Once we have your responses, we will inform you of daily carpools.

Arrangements for car pick up and journey times will follow.
